What to do to prepare

- * Have a good night's sleep
- * Eat breakfast and have a snack
- * Wear a short sleeved shirt
- * Try breathing exercises and mindfulness practices
- * Talk to your parents about what you have learned about immunizations
- * Good website is I Boost Immunity: Unicef Canada
- * Talk to the nurse, if you have any questions.

At School:

- * You will be called down to the vaccination room by class
- * You will be given your vaccine consent form signed by your parents or guardians
- * You will wait in line until a spot is free at a table with 2 nurses
- * The nurses will talk with you before giving you the vaccine
- * They will prepare the vaccine and then give it to you (feels like a pinch and pressure)
- * Then you go to the waiting area for 15 minutes and enjoy a snack
- * Head back to class . Remember to take home the vaccine paper that says you are done.


The staff of the Township came out to hear a few words and support us in our walk.

Super Start-Up!




