Grade seven and eight students will be able to see the name of their advisory class teacher, as lists will be posted on the boards outside the school. Then, those students will be able to make their way

to their assigned entrance to meet with their teacher. Grade six students will be asked to meet on the basketball court so that they can meet their Advisory teacher there, and learn the procedures for entering the school.
