Are you stuck for answers when a teen your life asks you the hard questions about their peer group? Are you looking for some insight about what's going on in the world of youth? Are you seeking resources and information for how to talk to your teen about, drug use, alcohol use, and consent and staying safe?

Saanich Youth Services in partnership with the Saanich Police Department – Community Engagement Division – Youth & Schools Section and the The Youth Outreach Team from Saanich Neighbourhood Place will host a two hour, trauma informed and harm reduction learning opportunity for parents, caregivers and youth. In this work shop, participants will have the chance to ask all the questions they need to. Gather all of the up to date information from police officers and youth workers in our community.
