The LLC will be available for students to tour their guests throughout the afternoon

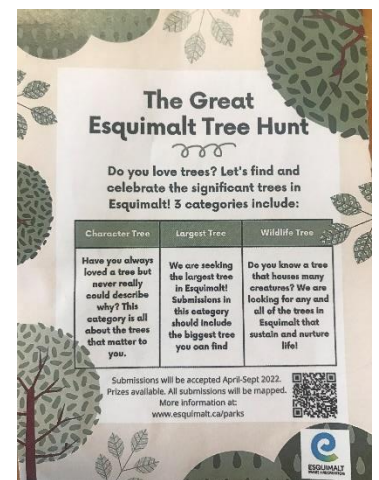
The Home Ec room will be available and have some examples of the Literacy activities that have been a focus of this year
