The first concept is that raven with wings spread and in the wings are the image of the wolf which is used by both of our local nations. The second is an image of the Ravens head holding the Sun in its beak which references the creation stories from this area, and the third is a Coast Salish design of a Raven in flight. These are just initial sketches and we are interested in your thoughts or preferences.
