Dear Families,

Welcome back everyone! We hope you all had a terrific summer, and am sure you are starting to gear up for coming back to school on Tuesday, September 6<sup>th</sup>! We wanted to take a minute to connect, and to welcome you and your children back to school for the beginning of the 2022-23 school year. The teachers, educational assistants, office team, custodial team and administrators have been eagerly preparing for the new year. Rockheights Middle School is ready for a great start and an outstanding year!

We realize that communication is important and many of you are likely inundated with messages and emails. We do ask you to please look for our **weekly communication that will be sent home to families each Friday (in this format)** to let you know about upcoming events and important pieces of information for your child and family. These types of communication, unless they are extremely time sensitive, will be emailed home at the end of each week, so we appreciate you taking the time to review them.

First of all, we would like to extend special greetings to all of our new students, families and staff. ***Welcome to Rockheights!*** For those that have not met me, my name is Aaron Maxwell and I have the privilege of being the principal here at Rockheights Middle School. I am proud to be a part of this community as I know it is a very special place. I look forward to meeting, or continuing to work with each of you to support your children.

For the first week of school, we are involving all of the students and staff in class and team building activities to promote school spirit, unity and a sense of belonging. Students will be organized in temporary classes as we cannot finalize placements until we have confirmed numbers. We intend to have students assigned to their Advisory classes by the end of the first week. If you are receiving this and know that your child will not be attending Rockheights this year, please contact the school immediately so that we can try to accommodate their move elsewhere.

On Tuesday, September 6<sup>th</sup> school will start at 9:30am and students will be dismissed at 11:30am. Grade 6 and 7 students will meet at the front of the school and when the bell goes we will walk down to the gym. Grade 8 students will be asked to meet in the courtyard between wing B and C outside the Library Learning Commons (LLC) as they will be gathering in the LLC when the bell goes.

Starting on Wednesday, we will begin our regular daily schedule, which starts at 8:35am and dismisses at 2:50pm. Students will enter the school through their classroom entrances and follow all of the protocols learned on Tuesday. No school supplies are needed for the first week, but please ensure that your child has lunch, a water bottle, and is dressed for the weather - as we will be spending much of the week outdoors.
