Student Learning Survey 2022/2023

The Provincial Student Learning Survey is a tool that gathers information from parents/guardians/caregivers, teachers, and students on topics related to school environment, safety, and achievement. The information is used for planning in individual schools and provides a district and provincial perspective.

We have been administering the Student Learning Survey to all grade 7 students and it is also open to their parents/guardians/caregivers, and all school staff. We encourage parents/guardians/caregivers to participate in this survey, as the results are important in identifying and celebrating current strengths, as well as determining where the school needs to focus improvement. The surveys contain standard questions for the Province – in addition, questions from the school and/or district that focus on local conditions or issues may be included.

The survey can be completed electronically and can be accessed on the Internet at

<u>http://www.bced.gov.bc.ca/sat_survey</u>. Any computer with an Internet connection can be used, and access to the esurvey is simple and secure. The survey can be accessed through the link with or without an anonymous logon code by selecting the school district and school name where your child attends school. Provincial, District and School Reports for previous years can be viewed at the same site under the *Results* section.

The e-survey site will be open until April 29th. If you have any questions, please call me at the school.

I realize that this is a busy time of year as we try to balance looking ahead to next year while still being present and celebrating the progress that students have demonstrated this term. Whether it is participating on our volleyball teams, taking part in our Gravity Car Races, reading daily for our Literacy challenges, or performing Random acts of kindness, there have been many opportunities for students to take on leadership roles and it is great to see students rise to the various challenges they are faced with.
