Dear Families,

Ready or not, here we go! I can only imagine that there are many of you that are excited for the return to school for your children and the routines that go along with that. We have been working hard to ensure that things are ready to go for all students when they return on Tuesday Sept 5.

On Tuesday, school will start at 9:30am and students will be dismissed at 11:30am. Grade 6 students are asked to please meet at the front of the school and when the bell goes we will walk down to the gym. Grade 7 and 8 students are asked to look at the boards in front of the school and please proceed directly to your classes.

If you cannot find your class, or need extra assistance, please ask any of the adults that are wearing staff nametags and we would be happy to help you out.

For the first week of school, we are involving all of the students and staff in class and team building activities to promote school spirit, unity and a sense of belonging. Students will be organized in temporary classes as we can not finalize placements until we have confirmed numbers. We realize that there may be some disappointment if a best friend is not in the same class as your child, but there are many factors and many conversations that go into class placements and we appreciate your support with this process.
