Curriculum Catch Up Afternoon – Friday December 2nd

Three times a year, we have a "Curriculum Catch Up Afternoon" in which students who are all caught up on their work are dismissed early, while those that are missing tasks from the term are required to stay to complete those tasks. A form will be sent home at the beginning of next week(by Wednesday) that will indicate whether or not your child is up to date on all of their assigned tasks. Students that are eligible will be dismissed at 11:55 (our regular lunch time) on Monday November 27. Those that are required to stay will be working in the Learning Commons until their assigned tasks are completed. Students are welcome to be dismissed once they have completed their work as long as they have permission from you to do so.
