#### **SD61 Cold and Flu Season Reminders**

We have reached that time of the year again! It is cold and flu season. As students return to classrooms for the new school year, as the leaves start to turn and the temperature drops, the tissues and sneezes begin to appear. Additionally, with COVID-19 continuing to circulate within our community, it is important to take extra precautions.
