Cell Phone Policy – We realize that many of our students have cell phones that they carry with them daily. As you likely know there has been a district and provincial mandate to restrict cell phone use in schools and on school grounds. We realize that these can be powerful tools when used effectively, but that they can also be very distracting to students and their classmates. The expectation here at Rockheights is that **cell phones should not be out during the school day**. Our

system is that teachers will offer to collect devices at the start of the day and lock them in their classroom closet, and then return them before dismissal at the end of the day. Or, as long as they are kept tucked away in a student's backpack, students are welcome to keep their devices tucked away for the day. If students have their phones out during the school day, teachers will hold onto them until dismissal time.

Cell Phone Policy continued: The intention of this is to remove the distraction

that cell phones can create for the user and other students around them. There are some exceptions, as some students use their devices to help them focus and concentrate while learning, and these exceptions will be on a case by case basis. Regardless, <u>any device should not be taken out prior to a conversation with the supervising teacher/staff member.</u> If you need to connect with your child during the day, please call us at the office (250) 384-7125 and we will ensure the message is passed on to your child.

We appreciate your support with this as we try to help all of our students balance the strengths and challenges that cell phones provide.

School Counselling at Rockheights Hello Rockheights Community! My name is Sondra Showers and I am excited to be back as the school counsellor at Rockheights Middle School. School Counselling focuses on helping children succeed at school. These individual or group services are short-term and focus on building relationships, resilience, and self-regulation. Common topics are social-emotional wellness, self-awareness, anxiety, emotional regulation, friendships, problem solving skills, and coping strategies. The length of time and frequency of counselling depends on the student's level of need. I make every effort to minimize disruptions to a child's classroom time.
