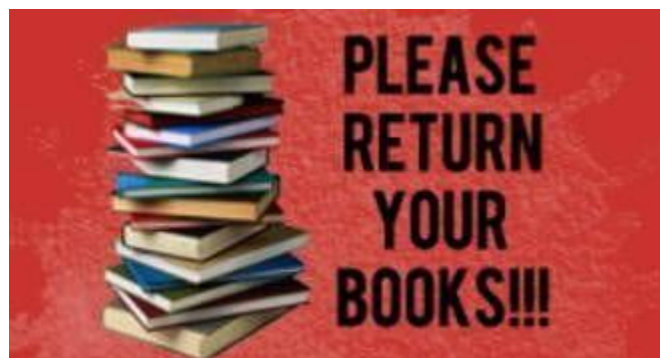

World Cup Reminders: - You may have heard that the City of Victoria is a recipient of \$35,000 from the B.C. government's \$1.7-million 2026 Community Event Support Fund to host free public festivities tied to big-screen viewings of the FIFA World Cup games. Activities in Victoria include viewing parties in Market Square, festivities at Ship Point, and along Government Street at many local restaurants and businesses. The events will be taking place over 10 to 13 days from Canada's opening game on June 12 to the championship game on July 19.

The activities are expected to be very lively and although this will be a celebratory time for Victoria's downtown core, there may be added safety measures to consider when planning active transportation routes for students to/from school and planning activities for your families outside school hours.

Staff have also been reminded of these events and will be in touch if any adjustments need to be made for pre-planned field trips and other school-related activities.
